Pursuant to Rule 47 of the 2013 Rules of the Senate Electoral Tribunal, only duly accredited party revisors, alternate party revisors, party counsel and supervisors shall be allowed to participate in or observe the revision proceedings.


ACCORDINGLY, the Executive Committee of the Tribunal Resolves to **GRANT** accreditation to all revisors, alternate revisors, supervisors, and counsel of the parties which are included in their respective lists.

The parties are, however, reminded that only one party counsel and not more than two party supervisors are allowed in the revision area at any given time, as provided for in Rule 14 in relation to Rule 29 of the Rules and Procedures Governing the Revision of Ballots under the Automated Election System.

Further, in consonance with Rule 48 of the SET Rules, the Tribunal may, *motu proprio* or upon motion of any of the parties, withdraw the accreditation of a party revisor, alternate party revisor, party counsel or supervisor for disorderly conduct, unruly behavior or for such acts as would tend to delay, disrupt and/or disturb the proceedings. In such cases, the Tribunal Revision Supervisor is authorized to remove or oust a party revisor, alternate revisor, party counsel or supervisor from the revision proceedings, and may prohibit such person from participating in subsequent proceedings.
