RESOLUTION NO. 16 - 78

In Resolution 16-70 dated 18 October 2017, the Executive Committee of the Tribunal granted the Motion of Protestee de Lima to photocopy the objected and claimed ballots and other election documents and paraphernalia, such as the Minutes of Voting and Counting (MOVs), Election Returns (ERs), Initialization Reports, Audit Log Reports, and Voter's Receipts from each of the precincts to be revised. The Resolution also required Protestant Tolentino to inform the Tribunal within two (2) days from receipt of the Resolution whether or not he will also request the photocopying of the said documents.

In a Manifestation dated 30 October 2017, Protestant Tolentino informed the Tribunal that he also intends to photocopy the aforesaid documents.

ACTING on the *Manifestation*, the Executive Committee of the Tribunal Resolves to REQUIRE Protestant Tolentino to PROVIDE a photocopying machine and ensure that the same must be in good working condition every day from the start of photocopying until completion; and SUBMIT the names and "1 x 1" ID pictures of his representatives who will observe the conduct of photocopying activities, both within two (2) days from receipt of this Resolution.
