

CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, entered into and executed this 11th day of January 2023 in Quezon City by and between the **SENATE ELECTORAL TRIBUNAL** (hereinafter referred to as the "Procuring Entity") and **MAXIMUM SECURITY & SERVICES CORPORATION** (hereinafter referred to as the "Supplier");

WHEREAS, the Procuring Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly the **Supply and Delivery of Security Services for FY 2023**, and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier in the sum of **Two Million Four Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Ten Pesos and 8/100 (Php2,459,410.08)** ((hereinafter referred to as "the Contract Price").

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. In this Contract, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
- 2. The following documents as required by the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Contract, *viz*.:
 - i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - a. Schedule of Requirements,
 - b. Technical Specifications,
 - c. General and Special Conditions of Contract, and
 - d. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any;
 - ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Performance Security;
- iv. Notice of Award and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- 3. In consideration for the sum of Two Million Four Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Ten Pesos and 8/100 (Php2,459,410.08) or such other sums as may be ascertained, MAXIMUM SECURITY & SERVICES CORPORATION agrees to supply and deliver security services for FY 2023 in accordance with its Bid.
